


# Hebrews 4:8—11

[11] Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, so that no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience.



*We are offered the fullness of rest

foreshadowed by physical safety  
from enemies in the Old Testament*

# 1 Kings 5:3-5

[3] “You know that David my father could not build a house for the name of the LORD his God because of the warfare with which his enemies surrounded him, until the LORD put them under the soles of his feet. [4] But now the LORD my God has given me rest on every side. There is neither adversary nor misfortune. [5] And so I intend to build a house for the name of the LORD my God, as the LORD said to David my father, ‘Your son, whom I will set on your throne in your place, shall build the house for my name.’

# Zechariah 6:12-13

[12] And say to him, "Thus says the LORD of hosts, "Behold, the man whose name is the Branch: for he shall branch out from his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD. 

the eternal ruler of the Kingdom.*




